JOB DESCRIPTION

Course Ranger

Reports To:	Outside Operations Supervisor or Assistant Golf Professional
Directly Manages:	None
Classification:	Regular Part-Time or Temporary/Seasonal
Working Hours:	Less Than 30 Hours Per Week
Duties:	The Ranger monitors play on the golf course. He reminds players of special play conditions, such as keeping carts on cart paths, and politely requests slow groups to speed up play.

Specifically, the Course Ranger must:

- Greet and welcome all patrons and positively promote the service philosophy of HGG.
- Communicate emergency and safety information to members and guests in a calm and clear professional manner.
- Observe play on the golf course and ensure the standard "pace of play" is maintained daily. Requires the use of a two-way radio for constant communication with Golf Shop.
- Assist patrons with information that may help them play the course (e.g., yardage markers on sprinkler heads to middle of green).
- Operate safely a gas and/or electric golf cart on grass or hard surface. Cart must be returned to storage properly cleaned and in good repair. Requires employee to bend, stoop, and stand for up to three (3) hours without a break.
- Be able to lift up to 70 pounds.

This job description includes, but is not limited to, the duties and responsibilities noted above. The essential functions of this job description are not exhaustive and may be supplemented.
