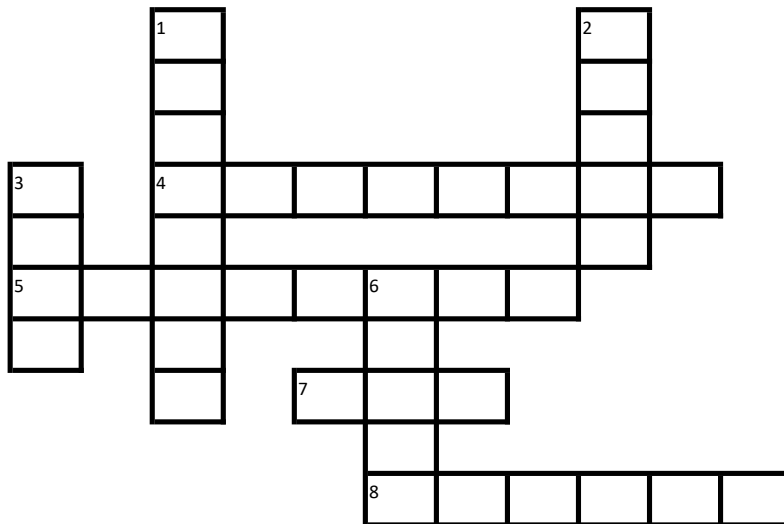


# Wild Cat Crossword
