MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: Ensures the attractiveness and constant readiness for play of the Gulf Winds Golf Course which includes 18-holes, and practice greens. Regularly inspects and evaluates conditions of the course to identify daily maintenance requirements and analyze specific problems. Determines the appropriate genus of grass to be cultivated based on nature and condition of the soil, climatic conditions and season of the year. Directs the amounts and types of soil nutrients and fertilizers to be applied to greens, fairways and roughs. Incumbent must know how to take soil samples and decipher results for necessary amendments. Incumbent is responsible for coordination of the selection, application and otherwise safe handling of pesticides and other toxic substances. Takes preventative measures to prevent damage to the course by small animals. Must be able to recognize turf damage by fungus and insects. Prepares and submits annual budget estimates for course maintenance and submits request for purchase of all needed materials, new equipment and maintenance of items on hand. Performs the full range of supervisory functions for assigned staff. Effectively supports the Navy's Equal Employment Opportunity policy, and ensures compliance with fire, safety, security, sanitation, hazardous material handling and other environmental issues.

- **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:** Must have attained, either through academic achievements or practical experience, a sound background in turf grass maintenance and established agronomy and horticulture practices. Must display a talent in the art of landscaping planting, and growing of turf characteristic to golf courses. Must be able to complete Navy pest control training. Must have the ability to communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
