USE OF MWR FACILITIES BY NON-FEDERAL ENTITIES

What is a Non-Federal Entity?

Joint Ethics Regulation:

"A non-Federal entity is generally a self-sustaining, non-Federal person or organization, established, operated and controlled by any individual(s) acting outside the scope of any official capacity as officers, employees or agents of the Federal Government."

Examples

- Navy League
- Boeing Aircraft Corp.
- Privatized Housing LLC
- Senior Chief's Association
- Wife's Club
- Navy Federal Credit Union
- Combined Federal Campaign
- USO
- State or Municipal Government

Restrictions on Interactions with NFEs

- Preferential treatment of an NFE
- NFEs operating on an installation
- Special status NFEs
- Official participation in NFEs
- Personal participation in NFEs
- Competition between NFEs and MWR
- Commercial Sponsorship by NFEs
- Fundraising by NFE on base
- Endorsement of an NFE

Restriction: Commercial Sponsorship

- Defined: providing promotional, marketing, advertising or other publicity opportunities to commercial entities.
- Only MWR can conduct commercial sponsorship on an installation
- □ No restrictions off-installation
- "Sponsor Recognition" is not commercial sponsorship/advertising

Limited Situations

- Contracted entertainment has pre-existing sponsor
- NFE's contract for exclusive use of MWR facilities:
 O-Club/Bowling Alley/ Golf Course
 - Event is for members/guests of NFE
 - 2. Recognition is passive in nature (signs, print, podium)
 - Recognition is aimed only at event attendees
 - Recognition is limited to event site

Restriction: Fundraising

- Fundraising on installations is subject to a number of number of different rules
- Fundraising is not defined
- Providing logistic support to NFEs—can be done
- Providing logistic support to NFEs for fundraising is problematic
- Providing service-for-a-fee is not logistic support

Restriction:

Endorsement of NFE Fundraising

- Employees cannot endorse or appear to endorse a fundraiser
- Exceptions: CFC, NMCRS, OPM approved disaster relief
- Its personal
- No signs in pro shop; heads, locker rooms
- Don't handle event registration
- "Private Outing"
- ...what they do in the privacy of their own tee box
