Subj: IMPLEMENTATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2026 100 PERCENT SUSTAINMENT FOR UNACCOMPANIED HOUSING AND FITNESS CENTERS AND POOLS

1. Purpose

a. To provide guidance on the Navy's direction to increase and track Sustainment (ST) funding in fiscal year 2026 (FY26) to 100 percent of the Facilities Sustainment Model (FSM) to support Unaccompanied Housing (UH) and Fitness Centers/Pools across Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC) Regions.

b. This document cancels reference (a) which is set to expire on 30 September 2025 and is a substantial revision and should be read in its entirety. This document clarifies roles and

responsibilities, standardizes after action reporting, and aligns with policies in references (b) through (e). Specifically, this notice revision updates the following:

(1) The requirement for both Regions and Facility Engineering Comments (FECs) to create a Special Interest Code (SIC) ST-SQ for Sustainment quality of life programs in Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) for FY26 to track spending of UH/Fitness Centers and Pools.

(2) Provides clarification execution of ST-SQ as it relates to Base Operating Support Contracts (BOSC) and Specific Service Contracts.

(3) Clarification on process to move ST to ST-SQ if a region decides to exceed their initial ST-SQ controls.

(4) Clarification on movement of ST-SQ Region non labor controls to NAVAL Facilities Engineering Systems Command (NAVFAC) ST-SQ non labor controls if required to support purchase of shop materials to support execution of a project conducted by shop forces.

(5) Updates region project and financial reporting from monthly to quarterly except for Q4 when additional reporting may be required.

(6) Updates Enclosure (2), List of Applicable facilities for FY26 and Enclosure (5) the ST-SQ Expenditures reporting spreadsheet

2. Background. Per reference (b), facilities ST funding provides for maintenance and repair activities necessary to keep a typical inventory of facilities in good working order over its expected service life and includes preventive maintenance, facility emergency response and service calls, repair/replacement of facility components that are expected to occur within a 50-year service life and maintenance/regulatory inspections. ST requirements are modeled via the OSD Facilities Sustainment Model (FSM) and used as a basis for ST funding requirements. Historically, CNIC has been resourced to between 65 percent through 85 percent of the FSM requirement. Reference (c) directed an increase to ST funding for UH, Fitness Centers and Pools above original resourced levels in FY24. Per Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) direction, ST will be resourced to 100 percent of the FSM model for UH, Fitness Centers and Pools. This note provides direction on development of the spending plan and tracking for UH, Fitness Centers and Pools for FY26.

3. Scope and Applicability. Scope and applicability are as follows below:

a. Applicability. This Notice applies to all CNIC Headquarters (HQ) and Region UH/Fitness Centers and Pool facilities that fall under the Category Codes listed in enclosure (1) that receive ST funding and fall under the CNIC Maintenance Unit Identification Code (MUIC) and that have a Real Property Asset (RPA) Operational Status of Active and Semi Active only

unless the facilities fall under the categories of exceptions as noted in section 3a (2) of this notice and enclosure (2). Increased ST funding will apply to both Operations and Maintenance, Navy (OMN) and Operations and Maintenance, Navy Reserve (OMNR).

(1) List of Facilities. A list of facilities that was included in the FSM for FY26 is listed as Active or Semi-Active as of FSM version 26.2 is included in enclosure (2).

(a) The list includes those facilities that may have utilization category codes within the building. For example, there could be an administrative building that has a small part of the building used as an indoor fitness center. For the fitness center portion of the building, 100 percent ST would be provided for that area, and this notice applies to that indoor gym.

(b) It is possible that there may be additional facilities that are in the current real property inventory that are not on this list, as FSM version 26.2 is based on the real property inventory as of the end of FY23. The list in enclosure (2) is meant to be a starting point for the list of facilities but this notice covers all facilities in the Navy's real property inventory in FY26 that falls in the categories described in section 3a of this notice and enclosure (1).

(2) Exceptions

(a) Increased ST does not apply for those facilities that have an RPA Operational Status of Closed, Disposed, Caretaker, Excess, Environmental Hold, Non-functional, Surplus or To Be Acquired.

(b) Advanced Education Review Board (AERB) Facilities: UH buildings/Fitness Center/Pools that historically have fallen under AERB fenced funding per reference (d) are managed separately and are not included in the 100 percent ST funding for FY26. AERB facilities will continue to receive fenced funding at the 80 percent of FSM model per reference (d).

(c) Regions shall provide a list of facilities to CNIC HQ N4 ST HQ Program Director for exception consideration prior to a new annual notice.

b. Scope. Increased ST funding for UH and fitness centers/pools will be tracked at the Region level.

(1) Increased ST funding will be used to support labor and non-labor costs to maintain the standard of service via in-house NAVFAC Shop forces or Base Operating Support (BOS)/Specific Service contracts (i.e. Elevator maintenance, Heating Ventilation and Cooling (HVAC), fire protection, etc.) and to support in-house projects as follows:

(a) Standard of Service (Non-Project Work)

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1. Emergency/Urgent and Routine (E/U/R). Enclosure (3) provides a table with the new instructions for Service Desk for Emergency and Urgent Service calls across all UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools to be used across all applicable facilities listed in enclosure (2). Response times for Service calls for Emergency/Urgent and Routine (E/U/Rs) service work are as outlined in reference (e). Emergency and Urgent Service calls must be executed.

2. Preventive Maintenance. All preventive maintenance for UH/Fitness Centers and Pools must be executed as required in reference (f), unless deferred by the Installation Commanding Officer in the method described in reference (f).

(2) Remaining ST funds will be used to fund discretionary projects as part of the Region Maintenance Execution Plan (MEP) for facilities listed in enclosure (2).

(a) Projects will be tracked at the Region level for reporting. If the region determines spending for UH/Fitness Centers/ Pools needs to be prioritized at one installation over another due to condition of the facility or other issues, the Region Commander (REGCOM) has the authority to move controls available for MEP that is slated for UH/Fitness Centers/ Pools from one installation to another.

(b) Ancillary or Stand-Alone Support Facilities. Increased ST funding can be used for projects that directly support a specific UH building or building complex, Fitness Center, Gym, or Pool and that has a category code listed in enclosure (1). The project must have a direct impact to Quality of Life and Quality of Service for those facilities. Examples are as follows:

1. Use of funds to improve a chiller or boiler plant that ONLY supports a specific UH or Fitness Center would be acceptable use of the increased ST, but use of the funds on a central plant that supports UH, Administrative or other facilities is not acceptable.

2. A waterline that specifically services that UH or fitness center may fall under the 100 percent ST but a water main that services multiple facilities would not. In general, when the determination is difficult to conclude, it is likely that this would NOT fall under the intent of the 100 percent ST initiative and should be addressed separately.

4. Action

a. CNIC HQ/NAVFAC HQ.

(1) CNIC HQ N4

(a) Controls Amount. CNIC HQ N4 ST HQ Program Director will set Region controls for UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools as part of the FY26 budget controls. The breakout for UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools will be provided separately and released to Region ST Program Directors and for coordination with local NAVFAC FEC and Installation PWDs.

(b) Lead a working group made up of CNIC HQ N9, NAVFAC HQ PW and CNIC HQ N8/NAVFAC HQ FM on the FY27 update of this notice to be published by end of Q3 FY26.

(c) Collect reporting data from the 10 regions by the deadline listed in section 5 of this notice.

(d) Track completion of prior year funded UH and Fitness Center/Pool projects that were funded as part of the increased ST per reference (a) and (c).

(2) CNIC HQ N8/NAVFAC HQ FM

(a) Based on the controls that are determined by CNIC HQ N4, create at the region and Facilities Engineering Command a SIC ST-SQ for Sustainment Quality of Life Programs in Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) for FY26 to track spending for UH/Fitness Centers/Pools.

(b) Provide support and guidance to the field in the year of execution regarding ERP and ST-SQ.

(3) CNIC HQ N9

(a) Support CNIC N4 and NAVFAC HQ on developing tools for reporting and tracking of execution.

(b) Support dissemination of this guidance to Region N9s.

b. NAVFAC HQ PW

(1) Implement work-tracking methods for Labor/Non-Labor and BOS contracts.

(2) Work with CNIC N4 and N9 to develop and implement dashboards or other methods for tracking execution.

c. Regions

(1) Region N4

(a) Consolidate and coordinate with Region N9 on PWD project submissions to develop an integrated priority list for REGCOM approval.

(b) Work with PWDs and Region N9 to finalize MEP list for reporting to CNIC HQ. Using the project template provided in enclosure (4), report initial Region MEP project list with updates to execution monthly as stated in section 5 of this notice.

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(c) Collect and validate data from local FEC and PWDs that report tracking of execution of funds and projects via enclosures (4) and (5).

(d) Review NAVFAC labor/non labor execution data by end of Q3 and determine if any unexecuted NAVFAC labor and non-labor should be reallocated to region non-labor for the execution of swing MEP projects.

(e) For facilities where ST funds the sustainment of UH on installations managed by other services (i.e. Air Force) where the Navy does not control the maintenance of those facilities, monitor the amount funded to the other service for the sustainment of those UH facilities.

(f) Work with Region N8 on any adjustments between ST and SQ as required for execution.

1. BOSC and Specific Service Contracts. BOSC and Specific Service Contracts that have a Line of Accounting (LOA) for SIC ST must split the fair share costs for ST-SQ to be funded on a separate LOA for FY26 when the next contract option period is exercised or when a new contract is awarded. The separate ST-SQ LOA must be used as long as this action does not require a bilateral contract modification. In those circumstances, the ST-SQ funds may be converted to ST for contract funding. For all conversions, Region N4 shall keep track of what was converted for the financial reporting required in Section 5 of this note.

2. If a region decides to exceed their controls for ST-SQ by executing more projects for UH/Fitness Centers/ Pools than Region controls allow, ST may be converted to ST-SQ for this purpose to properly document spending in excess of the ST-SQ controls.

3. If it is determined that a project should be completed with in-house forces, and sufficient ST-SQ non-labor controls were not provided to the FEC at the start of the FY to account for the project, the Region may move ST-SQ non-labor to FEC ST-SQ non-labor to allow the FEC to purchase shop materials to support the project.

(2) Region N8

(a) Support Region N4 in applicable conversions of controls from ST-SQ to ST and vice versa.

(b) Support Region N4 in transfer of any ST-SQ controls to the local FEC as required for execution.

(3) Region N9

(a) Work collaboratively with PWDs and Region N4 to validate MEP project list for UH/Fitness Centers/ Pools.

(b) Inform local PWD/Region N4 of any facility related issues/concerns with service calls, preventive maintenance, and project requirements so that a solution can be developed to address whether it is within the realm of ST funding and budget constraints.

d. NAVFAC FEC and Installation PWDs

(1) PWDs update Service Desk Playbooks for response to service calls for facilities as shown in enclosure (2).

(2) Work with local installation N9 office to develop prioritized list of requirements for submission to Region ST RPD for consolidation and prioritization across the region. Once project prioritization at the Region level is completed, submit selected projects via enclosure (4) to Region N4 for monthly reporting.

(3) For existing BOS contracts where Option years are to be awarded in FY26, FECs and Installation PWDs will determine a "Fair Share Cost" to BOS contracts for UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools. Fair share estimate will be reported in enclosure (5).

(4) Report NAVFAC labor and non-labor spending under ST-SQ for UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools per spreadsheet as provided in enclosure (5) via ERP Reports and BOS fair share estimating.

5. Reporting. Regions must verify the projects that will be executed in FY26 for UH and Fitness Centers/ Pools by filling in the tables in enclosure (4). Updates to the project list in enclosure (4) will be provided to CNIC HQ N4 ST Headquarters Program Director quarterly with monthly updates for July and August and more frequent updates in September to track year end execution as required. Updates to NAVFAC labor/non-labor/BOS and specific service contracts will be provided to the CNIC SQ Headquarters Program Director at one month after the close of the end of every quarter (Jan 31st for end of Q1 ending December 31st, April 30th for end of Q2 ending March 31st, July 31st for end of Q3 ending June 30th and October 31st for end of Q4 ending September 30th) via use of the spreadsheet provided in enclosure (5). In Q4 of the fiscal year, updates to NAVFAC labor/non-labor and BOS specific service contracts may be requested more frequently by CNIC HQ to close out the fiscal year with full expenditure of the ST allocation. It is recommended that Regions collect the data from FECs prior to reporting to CNIC HQ.

6. Records Management

a. Records created as a result of this notice, regardless of format or media, must be maintained and dispositioned per the records disposition schedules located on the Department of the Navy Assistant for Administration, Directives and Records Management Division portal page

8. Cancellation Contingency. This notice is in effect for FY26 and expires on 30 September 2026 unless it is superseded by another notice or instruction, whichever occurs first.
